

LESSON PLAN

Topic:	How can we reuse recycled waste?		
Age:	10-12	English Level:	A1
Location:	Classroom	Duration:	1 lesson

Related subjects:	Art (Design), English
Material needed:	Paper, pens
Aims:	<p>Get ideas how plastic waste is already reused (e.g. jerseys, shoes)</p> <p>Develop more ideas how recycled waste can be reused.</p> <p>Present the ideas in English in front of the class.</p>
Working procedure:	<p>The teacher shows photos with different forms of waste to introduce “waste words” like plastic/organic/paper waste. The students describe the photos and talk about what happens with this kind of waste.</p> <p>Afterwards the teacher gives some examples e.g. Adidas shoes made of plastic waste, ONeil Bikinis made of waste from the oceans, or the project “Recycled Park” in Rotterdam.</p> <p>The class is divided into groups of 4-5 students.</p> <p>The students have to come up with their own ideas how we can use waste and make new things out of it. They should draw their ideas on a piece of paper.</p>
