



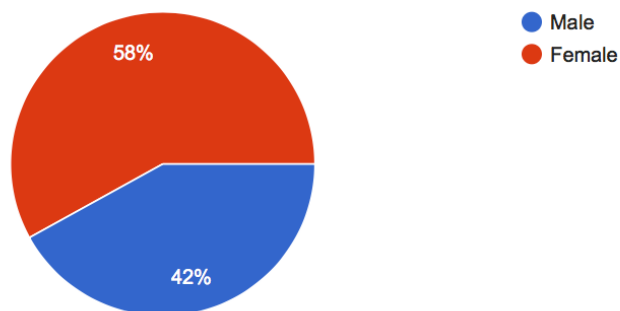
## Results of activity: Questionnaire about water habits

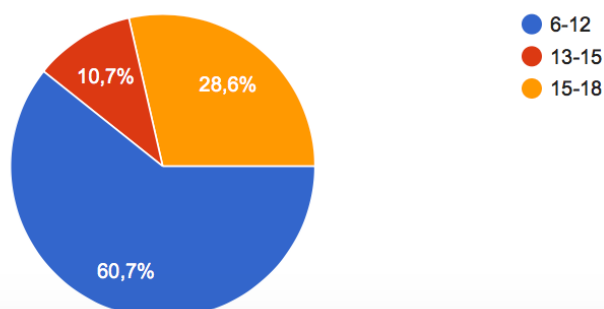
The aim of this questionnaire is to make students awareness of the use of water at their homes, and register the different results

Back in Spain, the same questionnaire was answered by the same number of pupils, and this is the result:

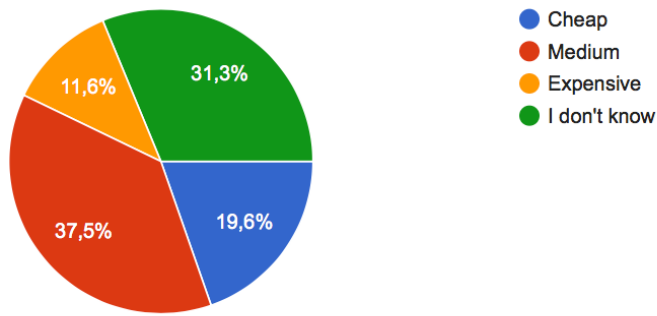
### Gender (112 respuestas)



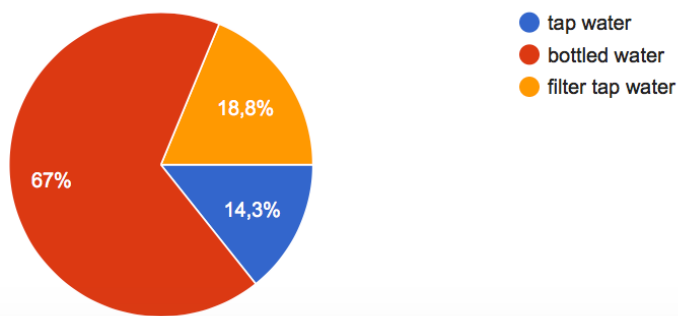
### Age range (112 respuestas)



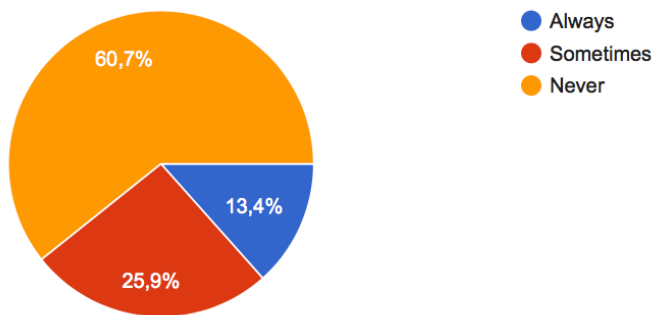
How expensive is water in your area? (112 respuestas)



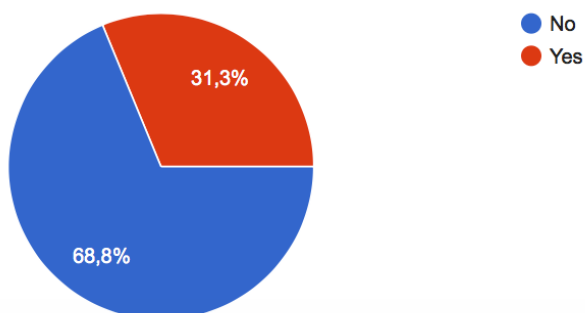
Do you usually drink (112 respuestas)



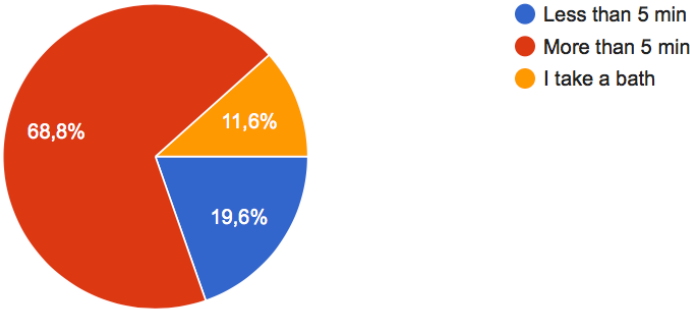
Do you usually leave the water run while brushing your teeth? (112 respuestas)



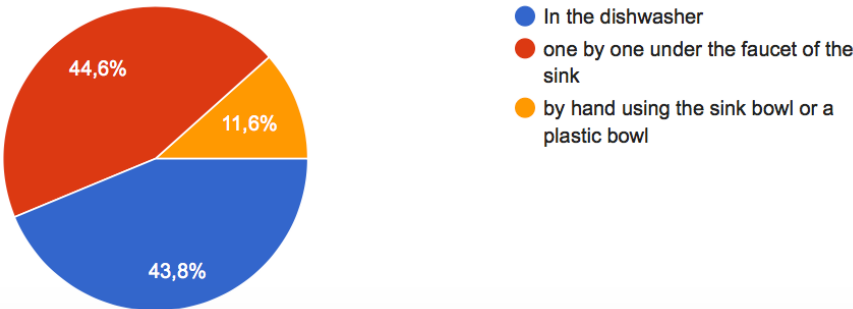
Does your family have a low-flow (a half-flush option) toilet? (112 respuestas)



How much time do you spend in the shower every day? (112 respuestas)

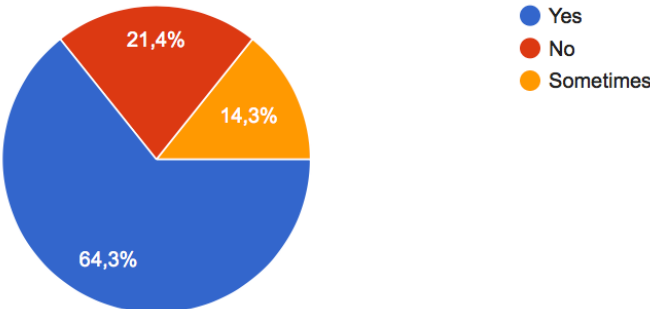


How does your family wash the dishes? (112 respuestas)

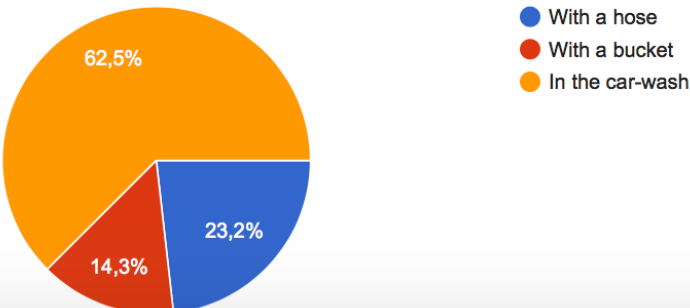


Does your family wait for the washing machine or dishwasher to be full before putting on a wash?

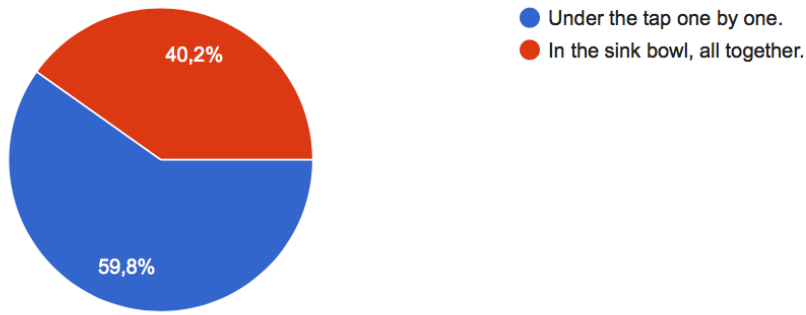

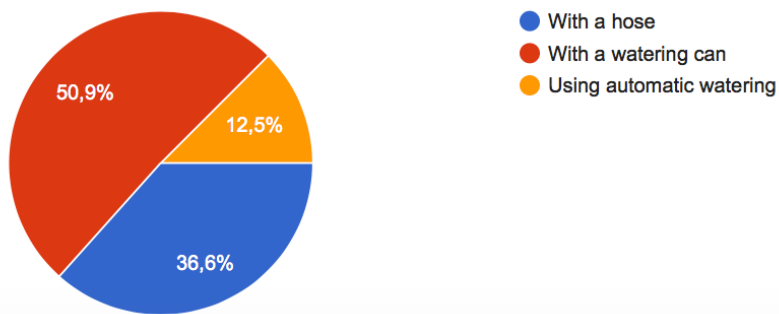
How does your family wash the car? (112 respuestas)



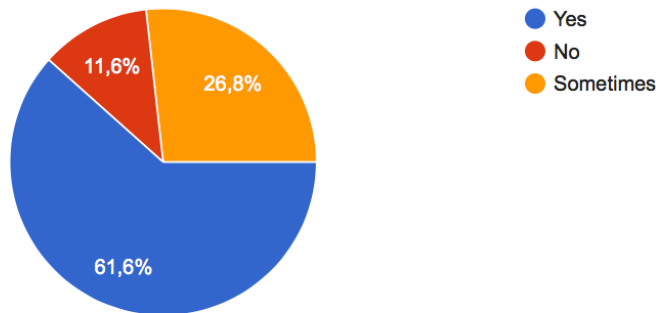
How does your family wash the vegetables and fruits; (112 respuestas)



How does your family water the plants? (112 respuestas)

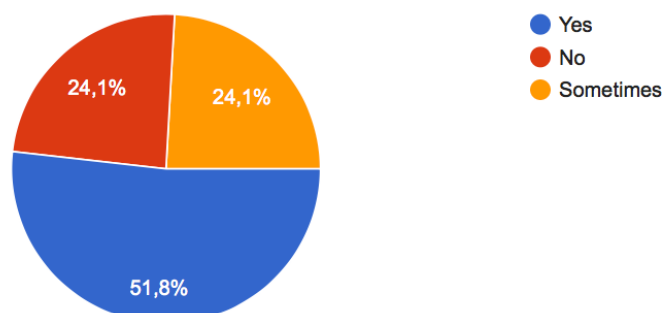


Do you leave the tap running waiting for cold or hot water? (112 respuestas)
